Demographics--Gender

Although the State of Montana and Montana State University do not have a high degree of diversity, the School has made some progress since the last accreditation visit. There has been some increase in almost all areas of diverse populations and the percentage of white students has declined from 90% and 95% in the overall student population and M.Arch program, respectively, to approximately 85% in both MSU and the School of Architecture. The School is more in line with the University percentages in this category and in other student demographic categories—such as Asian and Hispanic/Latino in the M.Arch program—the School has greater diversity than the University as a whole. When our undergraduate and graduate programs are combined there has also been an increase in the percentage of Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islanders.

In terms of gender diversity amongst students, the percentage of female students has varied from a low of 26% to a high of 38% with the higher percentage being in the most recent year. However, we have lagged well behind the University average in this area. As mentioned in previous sections, the School is working to increase its diversity of faculty which we believe will have an impact on attracting and retaining more female students in our program. Data is shown in the charts on the following page.

Environmental Design- Overall

Since 2007-08, as a result of the 2006 approved expansion of the MSU Architecture program, the school has been able to formally accept up to 91 students each year into the second year of the Environmental Design Program. This enrollment number was in effect up until Fall 2010 when our student numbers began to drop and enrollment has dropped approximately 33%. Over the last five years, an average of 77% of those students who complete the entire first year design sequence—ARCH 151 and 152—have been accepted into the Environmental Design Program.

Time-to-Graduation

The time-to-graduation figures were calculated looking at all students that graduated with a Master of Architecture degree between since the last accreditation visit. Because of our staggered admissions into the M.Arch graduate program, students can enter in Fall, Spring or Summer Semester and thus we refer to each of these groups as a cohort. In 2009 and 2010, our Master of Architecture program was still a 2-semester M.Arch program. In 2010, the 2006 expansion cohort was required to take a summer undergraduate studio had entered the graduate program resulting in a 9-semester undergraduate program and a 2-semester M.Arch program. Beginning with the 2011 cohort, the M.Arch program was expanded to 3-semesters and the undergraduate program reverted back to 8 semesters.

We have looked at two different time-to-graduation rates. One is for the 2-semester or 3-semester M.Arch program. For this chart, 150% of normal time to completion would be 3 semesters and 4 semesters respectively. We also looked at the time to graduation for our students to complete their B.A. in Environmental Design degree—either 8 or 9 semesters—and our Master of Architecture degree program. In these instances the combined program would take either 10 or 11 semesters to complete and the 150% normal time to completion would be either 15 or 16 semesters.
